The on-line component of the course is to be completed prior to attending the first session.

All aspiring new Referees must successfully complete the OSSRC Entry Level Referee Training Course in order to qualify as a USSF Referee. The training consists of following items:

1. OSSRC On-Line Training - This is an integral part of the overall referee training module and it is **mandatory** that it be completed prior to attending your first classroom clinic session. It is expected that this should require at least three(3) hours and up to six(6) hours of your time to complete this portion of the training. 2. Classroom Clinic Sessions - All clinic sessions (1, 2 and 3) are to be taken in the order of and at the same clinic location. Attending clinic sessions 1, 2 and 3 at different locations is not acceptable, i.e. you must pre-register for the same clinic for all three sessions. Any variation to this policy must be pre-approved the District Referee Administrator.

3. Outdoor Field Session - Attend an outdoor field session at any scheduled location

4. Written Examination - Must successfully pass a written test on the Laws of the Game

The minimum age is 14 years old, i.e. born prior to year 2005 (and will turn 14 at any time during the 2018 calendar year).

Pre-Registration is required. Attendees need to pre-register on-line at: <http://www.ossrc.com/newrefreg/newrefereemenu.html> at least four (4) days prior to the first session they plan to attend in order to guarantee space in the clinic of your choice

1) Registration will not be accepted at the door. **Pre-registration and completion of the on-line material in its entirety is required prior to attending first clinic session.** Failure to complete all of the required the on-line training material prior to attending clinic session 1 is unacceptable and may result in being dismissed from participating in the clinic session.

2) The fee for the course is \$70 ... make checks payable to "**OSSRC**" (one check for multiple registrants is acceptable).

3) Clinic Sessions (in whole or in part) may be subject to cancellation due to lack of registered participants or Clinic sessions may need to be limited in the number of participants subject to the size of the facility or the site may need to be changed ... thus the need for pre-registration ... and ... the need for all participants to check the website for any last minute (meaning the day of) changes ... nothing is guaranteed.
