To: DSL Youth and Adult Referees:

As much of winter is behind us, it's time to start planning for spring soccer. Enclosed is your DSL referee availability form used to schedule DSL recreation games (including MSSA/HSSA for adults) throughout the spring.

DSL spring recreation season begins Saturday, April 6th, and ends May 18th. **Sunday, May 19th has been designated a make-up day for any cancelled days.** MSSA (middle school) games likely start April 3rd and HSSA likely April 7th.

On the availability form, under "comments", you will find noted specific events taking place on those particular Saturdays or Sundays to assist you in marking your choices.

Please keep in mind the following:

- MSSA players – If we are aware of your game schedule before we schedule referees, you will likely be scheduled for some Saturdays that may require you to find a substitute.
- Adults – Be sure and check for conflicts with other schedules (including children) so that you can accurately indicate your availability. Adults also must have successfully completed the Risk Management process prior to refereeing.
- All referees must have completed a concussion education course, an IRS W-9 form and Referee Availability form prior to refereeing.
- Select players – Check on tournaments you may be attending including MOSSL or State/President's Cup.

All: Please note that if your pre-printed form notes in red that Concussion Course or Risk Management is "needed", it is necessary to complete the information online and submit the certificate to the DSL office.
